Assumptions and objectives of the course:

To provide students with a fundamentals of telecommunications policy, regulation and economics.

Contents of the course (course description):

Telecommunications law: EU directives, Polish telecommunications law. From natural monopoly to competition in telecommunication. Liberalization and single European telecommunications market. Regulation, deregulation, re-regulation. Normalization and standardization. International institutions. Regulatory agencies. Universal services. Basic telecommunication economics. Optimal tariffs setting problem. Tariffs analysis and regulation. Cross-subsidy. Interconnection, access charges, access deficit. International settlements. Polish telecom market. European and world markets.
