### Prerequisites

### Course objective

Gaining knowledge about conditions and formalities functioning of social law.

### Course-related learning outcomes

### Methods for verifying learning outcomes and assessment criteria

Learning outcomes presented above are verified as follows:

Lectures: formative assessment: discussions summarizing particular lectures, solving legal problems during the classes that offers the opportunity to assess the students understanding of the raised issues.  
Summative assesment: the test consists of about 10 questions, passing threshold: 55 % points  
Tutorials: formative assessment: discussions summarizing particular tutorials, solving legal problems during the classes that offers the opportunity to assess the students understanding of the raised issues.  
Summative assesment: the test consists of about 10 questions, passing threshold: 55% points.

### Programme content

Lectures: Sources of law. Basics of administrative law. The procedure for issuing administrative decisions. Roles and functions of social instytutions related to road transport ( trades union, works council, employee representative, labor inspector ). Social insurance. Contract of employment (form of contracts, working conditions and pay, paid leave, staff costs). Drivers working time. Driver prossional skills and vocational training.  
Tutorials: Best practices and case studies in the area of social law.

### Course topics

The program includes issues regarding the role and functions of selected social institutions related to road transport, as well as legal regulations governing the employment of various categories of employees in road transport enterprises.

### Teaching methods

Lectures: informative, problem - based, conversational lecture using a miltimedia presentation, case studies, discussion.  
Tutorials: miltimedia presentation, case studies, discussion.
