Prerequisites

The student has a general knowledge of the rules governing business activities in the field of road transport. The student knows the structure of normative acts and their classification. The student is willing to deepen the knowledge of interdisciplinary subjects. The student is open to learning about new solutions related to the subject of education.

Course objective

The aim of the course is to familiarize students with the normative acts regulating the functioning of transport enterprises, especially in the field of civil, commercial and social law. An additional goal is to obtain knowledge in accordance with Annex I to the Regulation (ec) no 1071/2009 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 21 October 2009 establishing common rules concerning the conditions to be complied with to pursue the occupation of road transport operator and repealing Council Directive 96/26/ EC with regard to modules A, B and C.

Course-related learning outcomes

Knowledge:

The student knows the economic, legal and other conditions of the operation of transport companies.

The student has a basic knowledge of managing / running a business and an individual entrepreneurship.

Skills:

The student is able to obtain information from literature, databases and other sources (in Polish and English), integrate it, interpret and critically evaluate it, draw conclusions and formulate and exhaustively justify opinions

The student is able to define the directions of further learning and implement the process of self-education, including other people

Social competences:

The student is aware of the need to develop professional achievements and to comply with the rules of professional ethics.

Programme content

The subject matter includes issues related to contracts that can be entered into by persons working in transport or transport companies. The subject matter also includes the notions of tortious and contractual liability, the issue of international conventions in the field of road transport. In addition, the subject matter includes the legal forms of business activity, labour law and the system of driver training.

Course topics

- 1. Contracts most often concluded in road transport and the resulting rights and obligations, as well as their negotiations, issues of claims, contractual and tort liability.
- 2. International conventions in the field of road transport.
- 3. Conditions and formalities for carrying out transport activities.
- 4. Characteristics of commercial companies, principles of their establishment and operation.
- 5. The role and functions of various social institutions related to road transport.
- 6. Employers" obligations in the field of employee social insurance, employment contracts. The issue of holidays.
- 7. Basics of drivers" working time and the basics of tachograph system operation.
- 8. System of training drivers in the area of required permissions and improving their qualifications.

Lecture with a multimedia presentation, discussion, study classes
