A RECTOR'S SCHOLARSHIP

A SCHOLARSHIP FOR THE DISABLED PERSON

A GRANT (ALLOWANCE)

The application may be submitted by all foreigners who have an active account in the eStudent/ USOSweb system.

A NEED-BASED SCHOLARSHIP

The application may be submitted by students who have one of the following documents:

- permanent residence or long-term resident status permit in the European Union;
- a temporary residence permit (for the purpose of family reunification);
- decision on refugee status granted in the Republic of Poland or enjoy temporary protection or subsidiary protection on the territory of the Republic of Poland;
- a certificate confirming the knowledge of Polish as a foreign language at least at the C1 language level, issued by the State Committee for the Certification of Proficiency in Polish as a Foreign Language;
- the Card of the Pole or a decision confirming Polish origin issued by a consul;
- a document confirming that they are spouses, relatives in the ascendant or descendant of a citizen of the Republic of Poland, living in the territory of the Republic of Poland;
- a temporary residence permit, a temporary residence permit in order to conduct scientific research, or a document confirming the stay on the territory of the Republic of Poland in connection with the use of the researcher's long-term mobility, or a national visa for the purpose of conducting scientific research or research works.

All benefits are granted to students of 1st cycle, 2nd cycle and integrated master's studies, but not longer than for a period of six years (12 semesters). Within this period, benefits are granted to 1st cycle studies for no longer than 9 semesters, and for 2nd cycle studies - not longer than 7 semesters.

CRITERIA

A RECTOR'S SCHOLARSHIP — the application may be submitted by students starting from the 3rd semester of the 1st cycle studies and students of 2nd cycle studies

Prerequisite: all previous semesters of studies have been completed

Weighted average of grades – not less than 4.0 in the case of no additional achievements

A RECTOR'S SCHOLARSHIP FOR 1ST YEAR STUDENTS OF THE 1ST CYCLE STUDIES – the application may be submitted by students admitted to the first-cycle studies in the year of passing the matriculation examination

Prerequisite: in the 2nd semester of studies, the first semester of studies have been completed

A scholarship for the 1st and 2nd semester of the 1st cycle of studies may be granted only and exclusively:

- a laureate of the international olympiad or the laureate or finalist of the central olympiad, referred to in the provisions on the education system;
- a medal holder in a sport competition at least at the level of Polish national champion in a given sport, referred to in sport regulations.

A SCHOLARSHIP FOR THE DISABLED PERSON

- the application may be submitted by students with:
- disability certificate,
- disability degree certificate,
- a certificate issued by a certifying physician of the Social Security Institution (ZUS) regarding the total or partial incapacity for work or the inability to live independently, or a certificate of inclusion in one of the invalids groups.

The certificate must be issued by a Polish institution.

GRANT (ALLOWANCE) - the application may be submitted by students, who are temporarily in a difficult life situation not later than within 3 months from the date of the event entitling the person to obtain this benefit.

The allowance may be obtained no more than twice in the academic year.

A NEED-BASED SCHOLARSHIP - the application may be submitted by students, whose monthly income per person in the family does not exceed PLN 1051.

PROCEDURE

A RECTOR'S SCHOLARSHIP

• is granted for one semester (in the winter semester - from October to February, and in the summer semester - from March to June).

A RECTOR'S SCHOLARSHIP FOR 1ST YEAR STUDENTS OF THE 1ST CYCLE STUDIES is granted for the academic year (from October to June).

Deadline: The application must be submitted within the time limit set by the Rector. The deadline is final. After its expiry, it is not possible to apply for the rector's scholarship.

In the summer semester 2021/2022, the deadline was March 12, 2022.

A SCHOLARSHIP FOR THE DISABLED PERSON

 is granted for the academic year (from October to June), but not longer than until the end of the validity of the disability certificate.

Deadline: The application can be submitted from October to June. The scholarship is available from the month of submitting a complete application.

AN ALLOWANCE

is granted once.

Deadline: The application can be submitted throughout the academic year (October to September) .

A NEED-BASED SCHOLARSHIP

 is granted for the winter semester (October to February) on the basis of an application submitted in winter semester and for the summer semester (March to June) on the basis of the same application, provided that the monthly income per family member is not changed.

Attention!


Students starting their 2nd cycle studies in the summer semester must submit a new application.

Deadline: The application must be submitted within the time limit set by the Rector in order to receive a scholarship for the entire academic year. Applications submitted after this date are also considered. In such a case, the scholarship is due from the month following the month of submitting the complete application.

HOW TO APPLY FOR A SCHOLARSHIP


In order to receive a scholarship, an application must be submitted electronically by an individual account in the University's IT system:

USOSweb - first-year students of the 1st and 2nd cycle studies (choose: STUDENT'S SECTION – STIPENDS – APPLY FOR A SCHOLARSHIP).



eStudent – students of the remaining years of study (choose: APPLICATIONS - select the appropriate application from the list).
