# A EUROPEAN ACADEMIC EXPERIENCE

From Spring 2022, students from all seven partner universities in the alliance will have access to EUNICE's own course modules. These modules will be taught in English and, in a first stage, this academic offer will consist of 14 Master level courses, with the partners coordinating two each.

EUNICE courses will cover five main fields: Health, Smart Cities, Environment-Energy, Transport/Mobility and Sustainable Development.

Alongside the design of our academic offer, we are also working on the principles of recognition of training: the validation of ECTS credits, and other strategic and digital aspects and on the potential creation of new tools that make our students' learning experience easier, more complete and meaningful.





#### A DIGITAL PLATFORM TO GET US CONNECTED

During the Summer 2021, a EUNICE team of experts in Information Technology have set the basis for the development of an online platform aimed at the promotion of digital mobility for students, researchers, academics and staff across the seven universities that form EUNICE. A pilot functional mockup is already being tested from

the user interface and information structure point of view.

This portal will be crucial for our university communities from seven countries to access information about the different courses, laboratories, research and research groups, as well as to enrolments, registrations and e-training. The courses will be implemented in the Moodle platform, planned and built for EUNICE. We are currently planning the maintenance, configuration and programming of the EUNICE portal and Moodle. The aim is to get the first version of the system up and running during November 2021. In addition to this, we are planning authentication solutions that brings the usability of the service to the best possible level for students, teachers and researchers.



## **BRIDGE THE GAP!**

EUNICE aims to strengthen the link between university and society, and we have already started with our plan to ensure a greater, and mutually beneficial, interaction between our academic communities and the socio-economic environment they live in.

# How we are doing it

We have carried out an **audit of the environment** by collecting at each EUNICE partner university the socalled 'Third Mission Indicators' (e.g., patents, contracts, spin-offs, internships) to implement the University-Industry cooperation mechanisms.

Our team is actively involved in scouting industrial **PhD grants**. We are developing a network of EUNICE Liaison Officers that will support the EUNICE researchers in the application to the now <u>open call 2021 of</u> <u>Horizon Europe MSCA – Doctoral Networks</u>.

Each EUNICE member university has contacted companies, NGOs, research institutes, etc. at their local level , to involve them in our **EUNICE International Internship Portal**, a novel opportunity for our students to get access to training in a company profile not available at their home university. Also, the web portal offers a chance for joint transnational internships coordinated at the network-level, which will



promote multicultural and multilingual work experience. The portal, in a pilot version, has been developed at the end of July, and will be available from EUNICE website soon.

#### Politechnika Poznańska (PUT), Poland



Poznan University of Technology is the best technical university in the Wielkopolska voivodeship in Western Poland. It is the third most frequently chosen university in Poland and is among the leading technical universities in Poland.

Founded in 1919, PUT boasts a century of experience in educating

highly qualified engineers and researchers in many areas. It is a place where students can gain experience closely connected to the reality of labour market. They are educated in accordance with the changing requirements of business and industry. (Among others - programme of dual studies, internships, interdysciplinary programmes).

Currently PUT has nearly 15,000 students in 9 faculties. Education is provided in 39 fields of study out of which 7 in first-cycle and 12 in second-cycle are given entirely in English.

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### Université de Mons (UMONS), Belgium

UMONS is part of the WORLD TOP 100 in the U-Multirank 2020 for the international orientation criteria and of the world's top 300 in the QS World University Ranking 2022, thanks to the 900 researchers and 10 thematic research institutes.

Created by decree in September 2019, the Université Polytechnique Hauts-de-France (UPHF) is the very first "polytechnic" university in France. This new model of institutional structure is based on a reorganization around



two poles: on the one hand, science and technology, and on the other, humanities. The aim is to support each student in developing a tailormade curriculum that is both transdisciplinary and international, and thus to promote their future professional integration. The UPHF currently welcomes 14,000 students, 14% of whom are international students of 85 different nationalities.

The UPHF's educational offer covers all levels of Bachelor's, Master's and Doctorate degrees in numerous fields of study, while offering an innovative interdisciplinary approach to the curriculum. You will therefore find the training you are looking for in French! Many

It is committed to ongoing sustainable development by measuring its impact on the environment using the Bilan Carbone approach proposed by ADEME.
