

List of required reference works (portfolio) for candidates for second-cycle full-time studies at the Faculty of Architecture, Poznan University of Technology

direction: **Architecture/Architecture (2024-25)**

The portfolio must be uploaded to the recruitment system.

A candidate from outside Poland applying for admission to full-time second-cycle studies at the Faculty of Architecture of the Poznan University of Technology in the following fields: *Architecture* (studies in Polish), *Architecture* (studies in English), Interior Design (studies in Polish) is obliged to upload to the recruitment system the portfolio.

The portfolio presents the Candidate's authorial output to date in the field of architectural design and drawing skills, being documentation of work (photographs, scans, jpg/pdf files) produced during the course of study and in the individual mode.

Upload deadline: from May 07, 2024 (start of electronic registration) to July 12, 2024 (end of electronic registration).

Place of upload: recruitment system, form section - documents

File format: jpg or pdf

Files: each point of the portfolio should be uploaded as a separate file containing the Candidate's digitised work (1 to 4 files). Candidates upload an additional 2 files with their Bachelor thesis.

FIELD OF STUDY ARCHITECTURE, ARCHITECTURE/ARCHITECTURE

MANDATORY PART

Candidates from outside the Poznan University of Technology are required to upload both their diploma thesis and portfolio to the recruitment system. Poznan University of Technology graduates only upload their portfolios, their diploma theses are located in the university's repository of written diploma theses.

THESIS (graduates from outside the Poznań University of Technology):

1. Engineering/bachelor's diploma thesis – written part
2. Engineering/ bachelor's diploma thesis - graphic part (min. 3 boards).

PORTFOLIO

1. Architectural designs - projections, sections, development plan, details, short description of technical solutions, visualizations, conceptual sketches, photos, mock-ups - the best 3 designs, 1 design on 1 board.
2. Urban designs - list of land surfaces, projections, cross-sections of the land, visualizations, details, short description - the best 3 designs, 1 design on 1 board.
3. Graphic works - up to 8 works, including at least 3 works made in pencil in the 50x70 format
The subject matter of the works should show a space drawn from nature or imagination and take into account the principles of perspective, proper work composition, framing, chiaroscuro, etc.

ADDITIONAL PART

4. Projects completed during internships along with a document confirming the completion of internships and references.

Candidates applying simultaneously for the following fields: Architecture and Interior Design upload:

1. Projects related to interior design - projections, sections, details, short description of technical solutions, visualizations, conceptual sketches, photos, mock-ups - the best 3 projects, 1 project on 1 board.
