RULES FOR USING THE CHILLOUT ROOM at the Poznan University of Technology Student Housing Complex

§1. General provisions

- 1. These rules set out the rules for using the Chillout Room (hereinafter referred to as the 'area') located on the premises of the Student Housing Complex (hereinafter referred to as the 'DS').
- 2. The zone is a common area intended for relaxation, socialising and spending free time by the residents of the DS.
- 3. Use of the zone implies to acceptance of the provisions of these rules.
- 4. The Zone is administered by the DS management.

§2. Rules for using the Zone

- 1. The zone is accessible to DS residents 24 hours a day, subject to the condition that quiet hours are in effect from 11:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m.
- 2. The space may only be used by DS residents and their guests, in accordance with the applicable provisions of *the Student Housing Regulations* concerning the reception of guests.
- 3. Generally accepted norms of social coexistence and personal culture must be observed in the zone.
- 4. The following are specifically prohibited in the zone:
 - 1) consuming alcohol, using psychoactive substances and smoking tobacco (including e-cigarettes),
 - 2) bringing in and consuming food,
 - 3) damaging, moving or removing items of equipment,
 - 4) using the zone in a manner that disturbs the peace or is a nuisance to other residents,
 - 5) bringing animals into the zone.
- 5. After using the zone, the user is obliged to:
 - 1) clean up after themselves (including disposing of rubbish),
 - 2) put equipment back in its place,
 - 3) turn off the television and lights,
 - 4) reporting any faults, damage or irregularities to the DS administration.

§3. Responsibility

- 1. Persons using the area are fully responsible for their behaviour and that of their guests.
- 2. The user is financially responsible for any damage caused by them or by persons for whom they are responsible.
- 3. In the event of a violation of these regulations, the DS administration has the right to:
 - 1) issue a verbal or written warning,
 - 2) restrict or temporarily revoke the right to use the zone,
 - 3) refer the matter to the relevant University authorities.

§4. Final provisions

- 1. These rules come into force on the day they're announced and are available in a visible place in the zone and on the Student Housing Complex.
- 2. Using the zone means you accept these rules and agree to follow them.
- 3. In matters not covered by these regulations, the provisions of *the Student Housing Regulations* and the regulations in force at the University shall apply.
